Change is in the air...

<u>Guidelines 2005 Update-</u> National headquarters staff and project team volunteers have been working on product and course revisions related to the first aid and CPR guideline changes. Here are some of the highlights for the changes that will be happening.

- Revised courses will have more hands-on practice time;
- Courses will have an improved instructional design;
- VHS tapes will be phased out and new videos will be available in only DVD format;
- An Epinephrine Auto-Injection Module for first aid courses is in development;

Development & Implementation Plan for the following changes:

• Spring 2006-release of the First Aid/CPR/AED Program

In the next couple of months more information will be sent out regarding these changes and how they will affect the materials and the final product. You can keep up to-date on the changes via the Instructor Corner on the Red Cross website; you can access the page at <u>www.instructorscorner.org/redcross</u>. It will become important that you are familiar with this website since you will need to complete your instructor update through the site. Your instructor authorization for the current program will only be valid through December 31st, 2006. If your certification is renewed in 2006 you will only be able to teach this program through December 31st, 2006 versus the normal two year certification period. A letter will be sent out in January with explicit directions on how to create a user account on the Instructor Corner and how to go through the update process. If you have been with us long enough you remember the update process for the current program and how you had to come into the chapter and go through the AED skills and a crossover to the materials. This is will be exponentially easier and more user friendly-plus it is a wonderful way to stay on top of what is going on with the Red Cross.

As I see changes being announced I will make sure to let you know what they are and how they will be affecting you. I like to keep you as informed as possible since I know that the students will ask questions and since you are the ambassadors for the Red Cross it is important that you are well informed.
